Reinstated On Retirement Rolls

A letter received from Mr. W. A. Hall was read to the Committee, which stated that Morton L. Baker, Badge No. 7183, 77th Street, who was originally retired on October 1, 1943 and returned to work March 15, 1944, was again placed on the Retirement Rolls October 1, 1945 and then returned to active service May 15, 1946 now wishes to be again placed on the Retirement Rolls. The Committee granted this request.

New Applications

The following regular Retirement applications were presented to the Committee at this meeting, as per attached list No. 79:

Nine from the Transportation Department, one from the Track Department, one from the Building Department, and one from the Executive Department.

The Secretary informed the Committee that Hagen Paulsen, Badge No. 7830, North Avenue Depot, whose Retirement was to become effective April 1, 1948 died March 16, 1948. The Retirement number given him is to be reissued to another employee retiring May 1, 1948. This makes a total of 2,017 applications approved to date.

The following Total and Permanent Disability applications were also presented:

Six from the Transportation Department, and one from the Track Department. This makes a total of 79 applications approved to date.

Re-examinations

Mr. Storm reported that two employees receiving Total and Permanent Disability benefits were re-examined in the past month. Our doctor's examination showed no material improvement and recommended they be examined again in six months.
