The Chairman called the meeting to order at 10:30 A.M.

On a motion by Mr. O'Connor, seconded by Mr. Johnson, the minutes of the 107th Meeting held April 21, 1958, were unanimously approved as written.

The announcement of deaths reported since the last meeting was made by the Secretary as per attached listing.

On a motion by Mr. Johnson, seconded by Mr. Moran, the thirty-six (36) applications submitted by the Secretary, were unanimously approved.

The Secretary reported that he had received an application for Total and Permanent Disability Retirement Benefits from W. J. On a motion by Mr. O'Connor, seconded by Mr. Moran, the Refund of Contributions to be made May 31, 1958, amounting to \$23,044.49, was unanimously approved as per attached listing.

The Secretary read a report of deposits, disbursements, and investments, during the month of April as per the attached report.

The Secretary read a report of Chicago Transit Authority bills totaling \$2,121.86, and miscellaneous bills totaling \$2,733.00. On a motion by Mr. Murray, seconded by Mr. Johnson, the Committee unanimously approved these bills.

The Secretary reported that he had received a letter from W. J. Kilmartin, Conductor, Logan Square, Badge No. 22427, asking that the Committee review his entered service date in the Retirement Files. The Secretary reported that the employe's original entered service date was July 14, 1928.
