The 204th Meeting of the Retirement Allowance Committee was held May 16, 1966, in the Secretary's Office, Room 746, in the Merchandise Mart, and the following were in attendance:

The announcement of deaths reported since the last Meeting was made by the Secretary as per the attached listing.

The Secretary advised that thirty-three (33) applications for retirement were submitted to the Office for presentation at this Meeting. On a motion by Mr. Flaherty, seconded by Mr. Moran, the Committee approved the thirty-three (33) applications for retirement.

The Secretary reported that during the month eight (8) employes on Total and Permanent Disability Retirement, as per the attached listing, were examined by the Medical Department or their records reviewed.

On a motion by Mr. Flaherty, seconded by Mr. Moran, the refunds numbering 56 and totaling \$86,722.43 to be made May 31, 1966, as per the attached report, were unanimously approved.

The Secretary read a report of deposits, disbursements, and investments during the month of April as per the attached report.


