## GA Subcommittee Meeting Notes March 2007

I would like to go through the General Administration items on the agenda for today's meeting.

From pages 1 to 3 of your package, the total number of deaths reported in the last month was <u>18</u>. This includes <u>14</u> retirees, <u>1</u> disability, and <u>3</u> surviving spouses. There are no pre-retirement surviving spouse allowances to be approved.

There was <u>3</u> Regular Retirement and <u>18</u> Early Retirements to be approved for a total of <u>21</u> for the month.

There is no new return to work cases for this month. There have been <u>98</u> people found fit to return to work since the beginning of the disability management program with Corvel.

There are more than <u>180</u> people who have been found fit to return to work with restrictions since the beginning of the disability management program.

There were 31 death benefits paid for the month, totaling \$171,000.00.

There are <u>10</u> refunds of contributions paid for the month totaling <u>\$90,464.44</u>.

There are <u>34</u> items in the Bills and Remittances section totaling <u>\$6,339,857.28</u>. Federal Income Tax deposits (FIT) totaled <u>\$1,257,329.95</u>, bringing the bills and remittances plus FIT deposit total to <u>\$7,597,187.23</u> for the month.

Item 4i is the estimated year-to-date Cash Flow Statement. As you can see, the Plan has negative cash flow through February, 2007 of \$25,574,710 million dollars.
