Deaths

Reinstated on Retirement Roll

Employees Returning to work A letter received from Mr. Hall was read to the Committee which stated that Frank W. Hoffmeister, Badge No. 4141, of Elston Station who originally retired March 2, 1942 and returned to work February 4, 1943 now wishes to be reinstated on the Retirement Roll effective July 1, 1948. Mr. Storm reported that Samuel L. Miller, Badge No. 6772, of the Transportation Department and Patrick Horan, Payroll No. 3383, of the Shops & Equipment Department both of whom had been receiving Total & Permanent Disability Benefits were examined by the Company doctor who found them capable of returning to work. Mr. Horan returned to work June 2, 1948, and Mr. Miller is to return July 1, 1948.

New Applica-<u>tions</u> The following regular Retirement applications were presented to the Committee at this meeting:

Twenty from the Transportation Department, Four from the Shops and Equipment Department, Three from the Track Department, one from the Material and Supplies Department, and one from the Electrical Department. This makes a total of 2,059 applications approved to date.

There were also 10 Total and Permanent Disability applications from the Transportation Department presented. This makes a total of 92 applic tions approved to date. All new applications are as per attached list No. 81. Mr. Simmons made a motion seconded by Mr. Devane that the 29 regular and 10 Total and Permanent Disability applications be accepted. Motion passed.

Mr. Storm raised the question of the Yearly Audit of the Retirement Plan and stated that the Company auditors have made this audit in previous years.

Annual Audit Mr. Devane made a motion seconded by Mr. Hall that the Company auditors again be asked to make the Seventh Annual Audit. Motion passed.

Re-<u>examinations</u> Mr. Storm also reported that seven (7) employees receiving Total and Permanent Disability Benefits were re-examined in the past month.

Mr. S. D. Forsythe stated the next meeting of the Retirement Allowance Committee would be held on July 19, 1948, at 11:00 A.M.
