The Secretary advised that thirty-five (35) applications for retirement were submitted to the office for presentation at this meeting. On a motion by Mr. Scholl, seconded by Mr. Tiffy, the Committee unanimously approved the thirty-five (35) applications recommended by the Secretary.

The Secretary advised that Mr. J. H. Kane, who had submitted an application for Total and Permanent Disability

Retirement, has returned to duty as a Street Collector on April 20, 1969. Consequently, his application has been withdrawn.

The Secretary reported that during the month, eleven (11) employes on Total and Permanent Disability Retirement were examined by the Medical Department or their records reviewed.

On a motion by Mr. Kohler, seconded by Mr. Burns, the refunds numbering 59 and totaling \$104,816.02 to be made April 30, 1969, as per the attached report, were unanimously approved.

The Secretary read a report of deposits, disbursements and investments during the month of March as per the attached report.

The Secretary presented Chicago Transit Authority bills totaling \$7,139.26 and miscellaneous bills totaling \$12,665.08 for approval. On a motion by Mr. Murray, seconded by Mr. Kohler, the Committee unanimously approved payment of these bills.
