Meeting of the Retiree Health Care Trust Board of Trustees July 30, 2014

Meeting Minutes

A regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Retiree Health Care Trust ("RHCT") was held on July 30, 2014 at One North Franklin Street, on the 27th Floor. The Chair and Executive Director were present.

Mr. Zarate described the steps Marquette is engaged in to make the transition to Marquette as seamless as possible, and presented a performance report for the first two quarters. He reported that as of June 29, 2014, the RHCT had a market value of \$743,852,394.26.

- Ms. Donohue provided an update of the timeline, advising that a meeting is planned for August 12 to review the submissions of the bidders to provide services for the RHCT.
